## CIVILIAN PERSONNEL COMMAND-WIDE RECRUITMENT AND OUTREACH MATERIALS

1. PURPOSE. This Recruitment Portfolio contains information designed to be used by Corps personnel in support of recruitment and outreach activities.
2. APPLICABILITY. This publication applies to all HQ, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers/OCE elements and all USACE Commands, including major subordinate commands, district commands, laboratories, and field operating activities, having recruitment and outreach responsibilities.
3. CONTENTS. The portfolio jacket serves as a container for the pamphlets, brochures, and special inserts which make up the recruitment materials. The portfolio contents are divided into four primary parts designed to be used separately or in various combinations. Because of the versatility of these materials they can be used for a variety of functions and can be tailored to a particular audience. The four parts of the recruitment portfolio are as follows:
a. History and Vision Gatefold Brochure - "The Spirit of Nation Building". This brochure provides a synopsis of the history of the Corps beginning in the era of the Revolution to the present time. It highlights significant accomplishments and discusses current missions and projects as well as our future vision.
b. Employment with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. This pamphlet includes information about employee benefits, application procedures, suitability requirements, basic qualifications, competitive examination, and initial appointment. To supplement this pamphlet are a series of special topical fact sheets including:

- Student Employment Programs
- Veterans Readjustment Appointments
- Selective Placement for Individuals with Disabilities
- Clerical or Secretarial Employment
- Maintenance, Trade or Craft Positions
- USACE Human Resource Offices Address listing

c. Career Opportunities with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. This pamphlet includes information about the various program areas in the corps, the types of careers offered, and career development. This pamphlet is also supplemented by a series of inserts which profile actual Corps members and their particular career field. Additional career supplements will be developed on a continuing basis.
d. Mission Area Supplements. These supplements feature seven mission areas in the Corps and discuss Corps responsibilities and accomplishments in each area. The mission areas which are featured are as follows:
- Research and Development
- Military Facilities
- Environmental Protection and Restoration
- Water Resources
- Natural Resources Management \& Regulation
- Recreation and Park Management
- Disaster Relief
