Hot Weather/Desert Operation

This abbreviated checklist is not to be used as a replacement for the -10 series Tech Manuals or any other PMCS guide

Engine idling time must be limited. Under no condition should engine idling exceed a maximum of 10 minutes. Excessive idling can cause damage to engine.

HEAT

- Avoid long, hard pushes or pulls. Allow engine to idle if it becomes overheated. If engine does not cool down after 10 minutes notify maintenance.
- Check water temperature gage if in the RED zone or engine temperature warning light comes on allow engine to cool down 3-5 minutes.
- Check cooling system, air cleaner indicator and engine oil level frequently. Ensure radiator is free of debris or foreign matter.
- Perform daily and weekly PMCS and lubrications every 10 hours. (see TM 5-2430-200-10).
- To prevent fuel from overheating, the fuel level should be maintained above one-half of a tank. Overheated fuel can cause reduced power and possibly damage the fuel system.
- 6. Park tractor under cover or in the shade if possible.

- 2. Keep radiator core free of obstructions.
- 3. Keep engine air precleaner free of debris.
- Ensure sand and dirt is removed from around any fluid filler location before checking or adding fluids.
- Clean spouts of fuel containers and areas around filler cap on fuel tank before adding fuel.
