M12A1 DECONTAMINATION EQUIPMENT HOT WEATHER/DESERT OPERATION

M12A1 Decontamination Apparatus

- 1. Inspect the rubber hoses once a week for signs of wear and damage.
- Keep the cover panels and dust cover in place as much as possible.
- 3. Position the pump unit in a direction that will afford the greatest protection to the engine compartment.
- 4. Check drive belt adjustment frequently
- 5. Reduce sand ingestion by stretching nylon stockings over air cleaners.
- Emphasize proper engine cool down and shutdown procedures.
- 7. Set voltage regulators at lower end of specifications.
- 8. Increase stocks of oils and lubricants.
- 9. Keep lubrication to the absolute minimum on exposed or semi exposed moving parts.
- 10. Erect screens against blowing sand in maintenance areas.
- 11. Cover the gap between the fuel nozzle and the fuel tank filler neck opening during refueling operations.
- 12. Increase PLLs for the following parts due to high failure rates: All rubber hoses, gaskets, and seals. Air filters.
