FM 90-3, DESERT OPERATIONS contains detailed instructions for living and working in the desert. TM 3-6665-321-12&P contains detailed PMCS instructions for proper maintenance and operation.

- When operating the M88 detector in rain, damp or dusty conditions, the M88 detector must be fitted with rain caps and the M88 detector must be in the upright position with the nozzles uppermost at all times.
- 2. Locate the two rain caps in the pocket of the transit case lid.
- Gently push the center of each rain cap onto the inlet and exhaust ports.
- Remove the inlet rain cap whenever the Confidence Sample
 Test has to be done and leave it off only long enough to apply
 stimulant from the Confidence Sample.
- 5. Reinstall the inlet rain cap.
