
ITEM	DESCRIPTION	PROCEDURES
1	Circular level	Inspect the housing for dents, cracks, and breaks. Inspect the lens for cracks or chips.
2	Eyepiece focus knob	Inspect for smooth operation.
3	Tangent screw	Check that when finger tight, the instru- ment head will not rotate. Check that when loosened, the instrument head will rotate smoothly. Inspect the cap for cracks or wear.




ITEM	DESCRIPTION	PROCEDURES
4	Leveling screws (3)	Inspect for bends, cracks, or stripped threads.
5	Leveling head	Inspect for cracks or stripped threads.
6	Objective lens	Inspect for chips or cracks.



ITEM	DESCRIPTION	PROCEDURES
7	Aiming sights	Inspect for cracks or breaks.
8	Level dial viewer	Visually inspect the level dial for chips or cracks.
9	Focus control	Inspect for smooth operation.



ITEM	DESCRIPTION	PROCEDURES
10	Horizontal crosshair adjustment screw	Inspect for loose or missing screws.
11	Telescope eyepiece	Inspect for dust, cracks, or chips.
12	Automatic compensa- tor button	Inspect for damage.



ITEM	DESCRIPTION	PROCEDURES
13	Tripod legs	Inspect the legs for splinters, cracks, or breaks. Inspect the mounting hardware for damage.
14	Tripod head	Inspect the head for cracks and breaks. Inspect the fastener, spring, and plate for damage.
15	ACCESSORIES Sun shield (2)	Inspect for cracks or bends.
