# PREVENTIVE MEDICINE MEASURES (PMM) for COMPANY-SIZE UNITS

#### ESSENTIAL COMMANDER TASKS PRIOR TO DEPLOYMENT.

- Know the unit mission.
- Know the medical threat to the unit.
- · Assure unit preventive medical supplies are available and current.
- · Select and train a unit field sanitation team (FST).
- · Assure each soldier is trained in PMM.
- · Enforce PMM using the sanitation team and unit leaders.

#### ESSENTIAL LEADERSHIP TASKS IN THE OPERATIONS AREA

- Ensure unit leaders are supervising the FST food, water, and garbage operations.
- Assist the commander to inspect food, water, and garbage operations.
- Enforce PMM by all unit members.
- · Monitor construction of waste disposal facilities.
- Provide PMM training to each soldier.
- Enforce application of pesticides and monitor for reapplication.

#### ESSENTIAL FIFLD SANITATION TEAM TASKS

- Inspect water containers and trailers.\*
- Disinfect water supplies.\*
- · Check unit water supply for chlorine.\*
- Inspect unit field food operations.\*
- Inspect unit waste disposal operations.\*
- · Control arthropods and other animals in the unit area.\*
- Train unit personnel in PMM.\*
- Monitor status of PMM In unit.\*
