Hot Weather/Desert Operation

This abbreviated checklist is not to be used as a replacement for the -10 series Tech Manuals or any other PMCS guide

EXTREME HEAT/HIGH HUMIDITY

- The converter and retarder temperature gauge, engine coolant temperature gauge and air system/engine oil pressure gauges should all be in the green range during operation.
- 2. Maintain engine coolant level to within ½ inch of the bottom of the fill pipe.
- Check oil levels frequently to ensure proper levels are maintained and seals are not leaking.
- Maintain batteries accordingly given the environment and check them regularly.
- Check fuel levels and tire pressures daily and nightly as much as possible.
- Drain fuel lines daily and nightly when necessary and possible.

DUSTY OR SANDY AREAS

- Check hydraulic tubes and hoses for wear and/or fraying, as well as, loose mounting hardware and leaks.
- 2. Attend to any leaks or cracks promptly.
- 3. Check lubrication points/areas frequently.
- Use caution when performing maintenance on cylinders and areas where fluids may be exposed.
- Oil should be changed twice as often than would normally occur.

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
