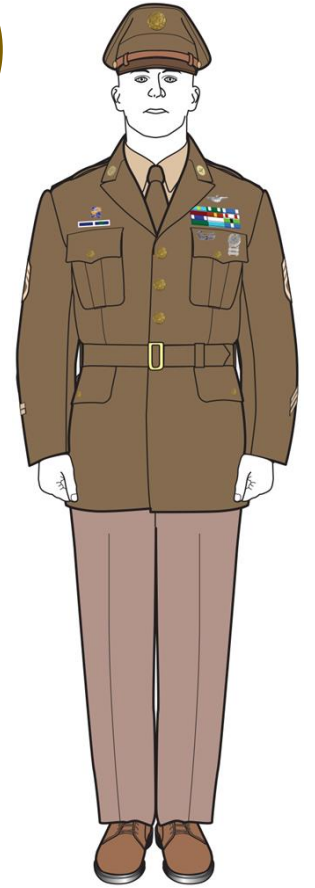
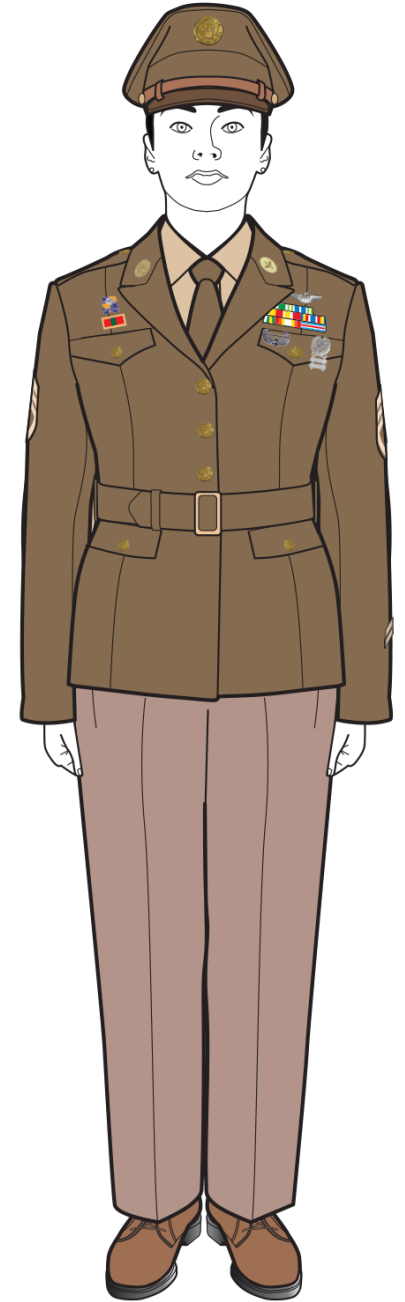
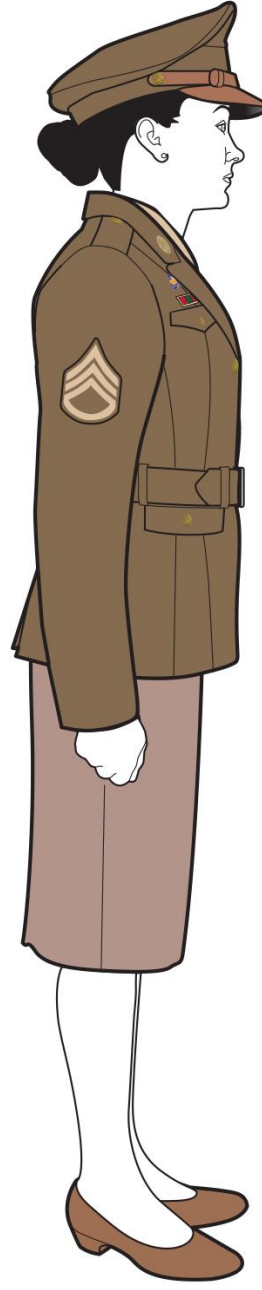
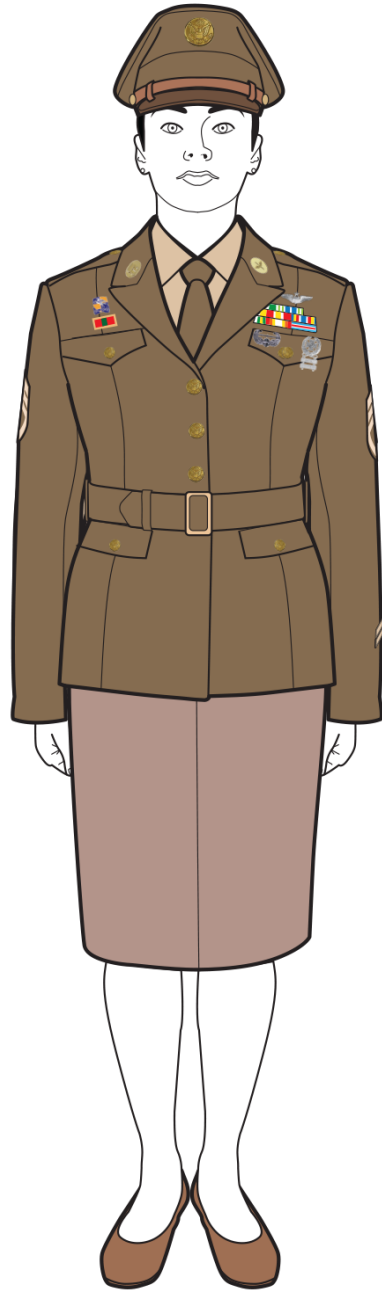
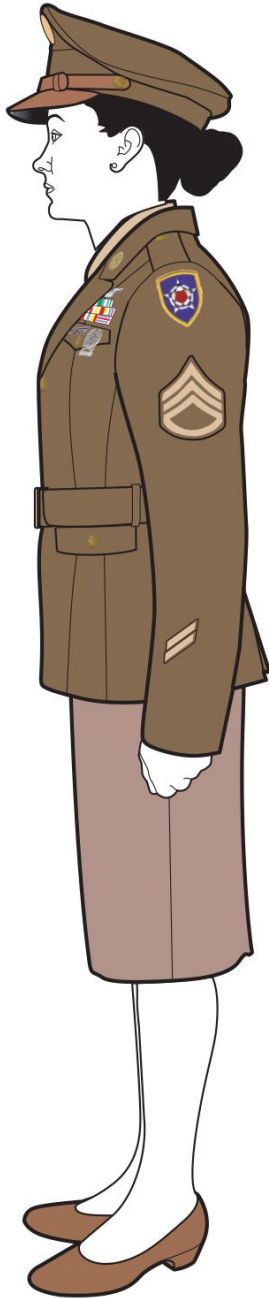


Army Green Service Uniform (AGSU) Fit and Wear Guidelines

AGSU Enlisted - Female Fit Guidelines



Coat – AGSU Female Fit:

- The coat should fit easily over the chest and shoulders.
- The shoulders should not be falling more than 3/8" past the natural shoulder point (3/4" total) or 3/8" narrower than the shoulder point at each side (3/4" total).
- The coat collar should fit close around the neck without gapping or overlapping, with the shirt collar showing at least 1/4 to 1/2 inch above the coat collar at the center back of the coat.
- The sleeves should fall 1 inch below the bottom of the wrist bone, covering the shirt sleeve.
- The bottom edge of the coat is 1 inch above the crotch, falling approximately to the tip of the thumb when standing at the position of attention or not more than 1/2" below the thumb.
- Coat front and back should be smooth and even at the bottom edges, with no protruding or spreading.
- Tip of the waist belt should line up with the button of the chest flaps (or bottom points) when cinched at the waist.
- Waistline should not have more ease than 1 1/2", when belted:
- Front of the coat should be smooth in along the lower pocket flaps
- Flaps should not be breaking or gapping and should be smooth around the Center Back Vent of the coat.
- There can be a slight ease along the waist of the coat in the area other than pocket flaps and CB vent.

AGSU Enlisted Female Fit Guidelines



Over-blouse (Short and Long sleeve):

- Shoulders should fit easily and do not restrict movements.
- Shoulder seam should fall exactly on the natural shoulder line, should not extend 3/8" past the natural shoulder and be 3/8" narrower than the natural shoulder (each side).
- Front and back princess seams should follow the natural curve of the body.
- Waistline ease should not be more than 1- 1/2".
- There should not be bubbling or gapping along the princess seams of the Over-blouse.
- Sleeve length on the long sleeve blouse should not be longer than 1" past the wrist bone.
- Long sleeve of the over-blouse should not extend past the Coat sleeve.

Skirt:

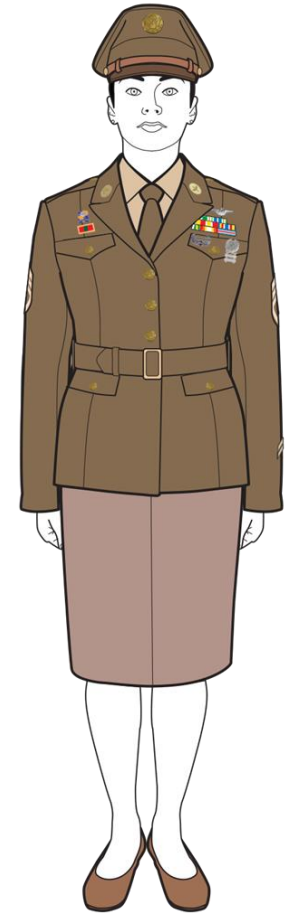
- Should sit below or 1/2" above the belly button level.
- Should not have more than 1 1/2" ease around the low hip area.
- The outseam line from low hip (8" from waist down along the side seam) to the sweep of the skirt should be a straight line without extra curved seams protruding from the natural shape of the body.
- The length of the skirt should be right below the knee or at the middle of the knee, per Soldier's preference.

Placement of top flaps (Female AGSU Coat)



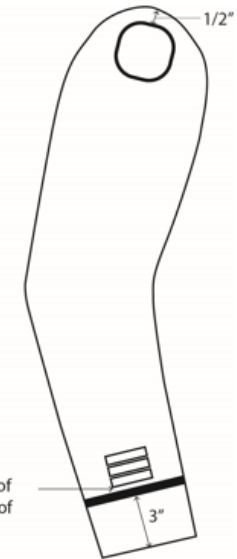
* A better position of top flaps on a soldier can be determined during alterations based on the size and preference of an individual

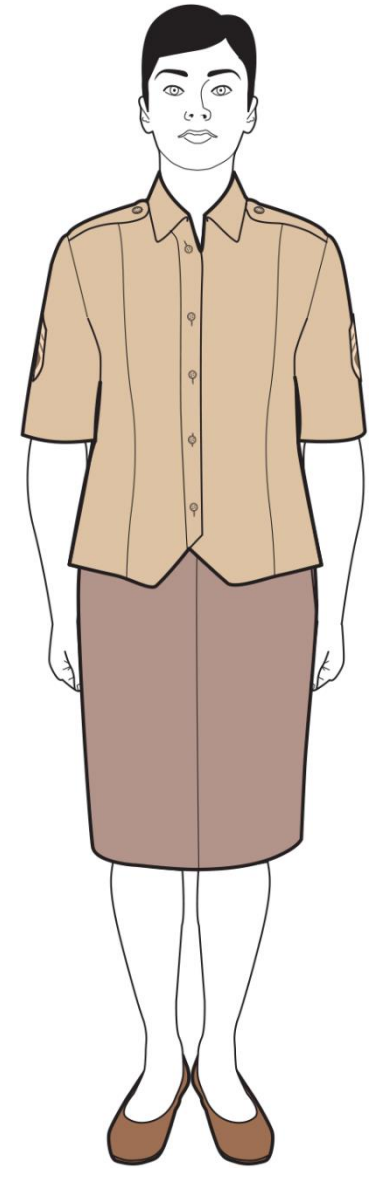
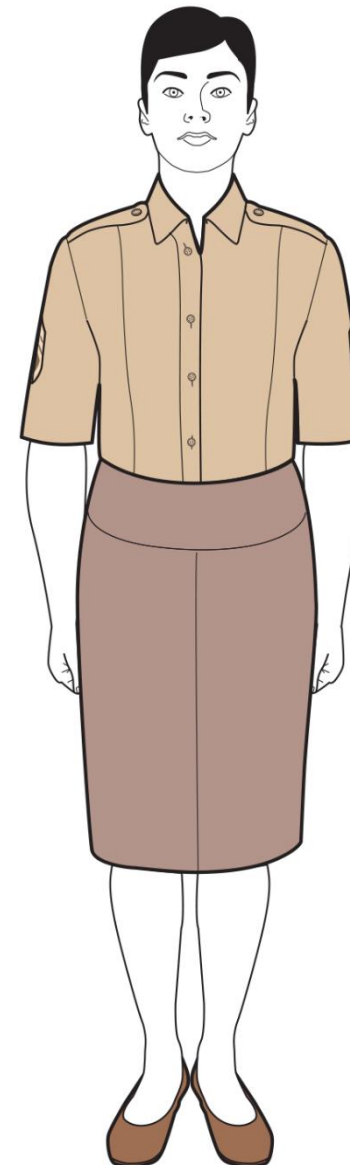
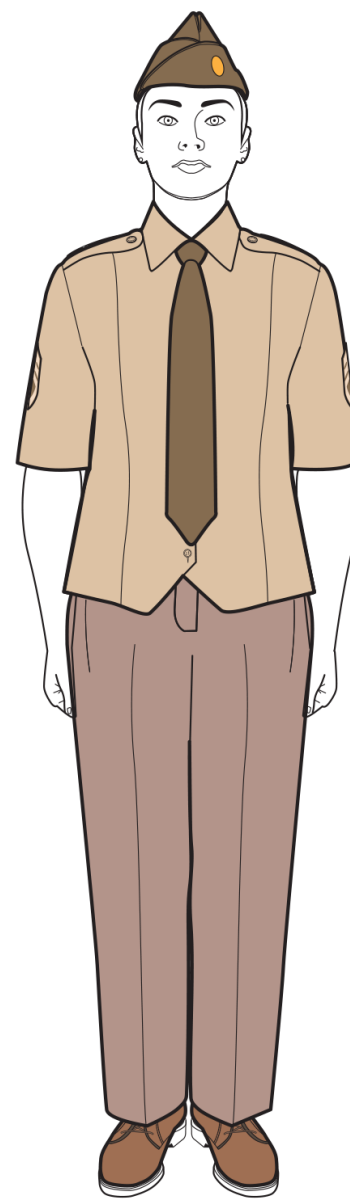
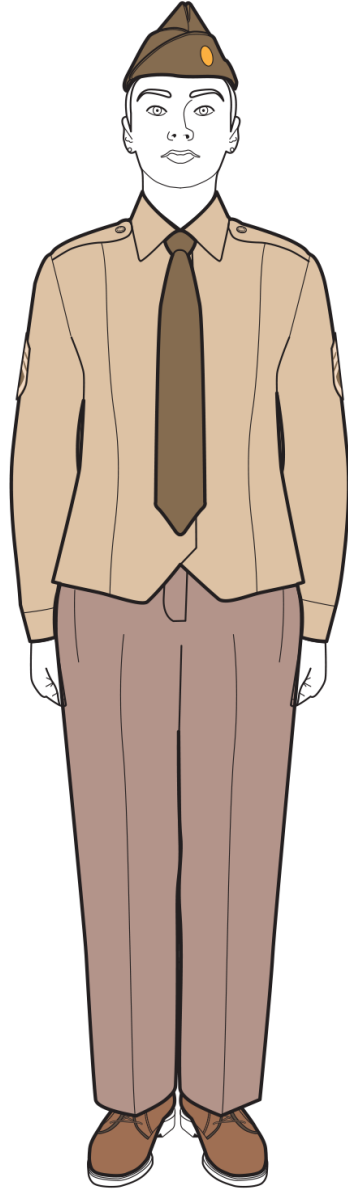
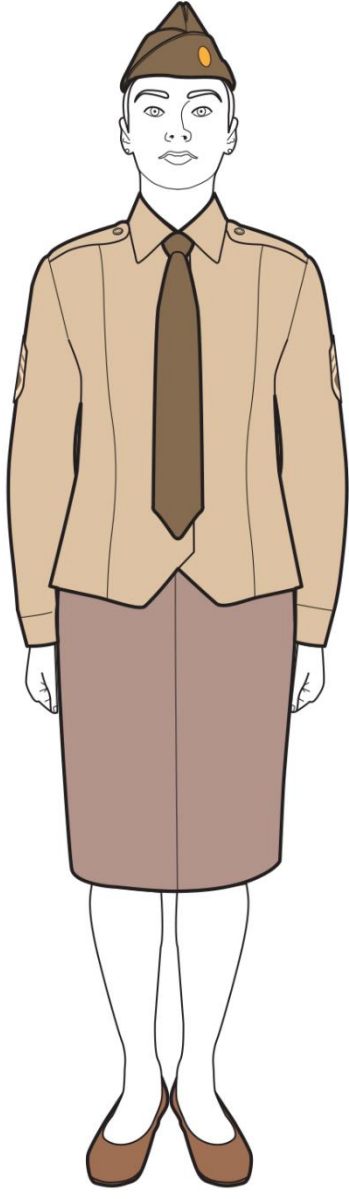
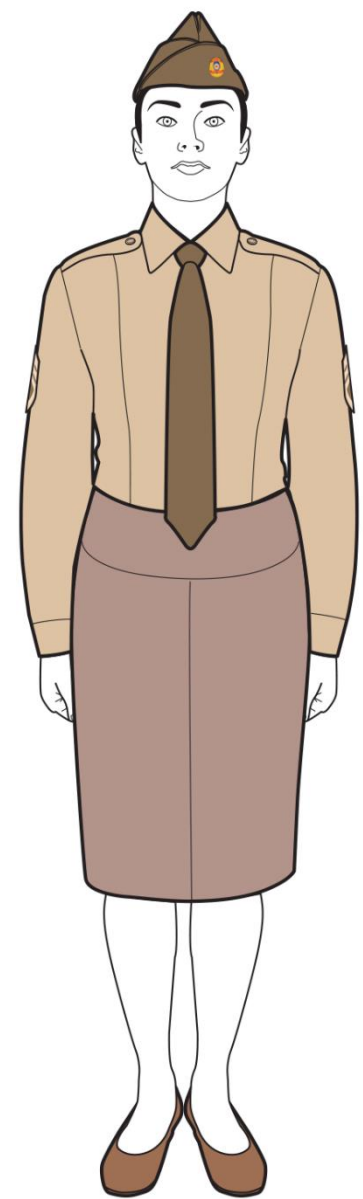


Left Sleeve	Right Sleeve
Unit Patch: Centered on sleeve cap 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam*	Combat Patch: Centered on sleeve cap 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam*
Sleeve Braid: The bottom edge of sleeve braid is placed 3 inches above and parallel to the finished hem	Sleeve Braid: The bottom edge of sleeve braid is placed 3 inches above and parallel to the finished hem
	Overseas Bars: Centered on the sleeve with bottom edge of the bars 4 inches above the finished hem

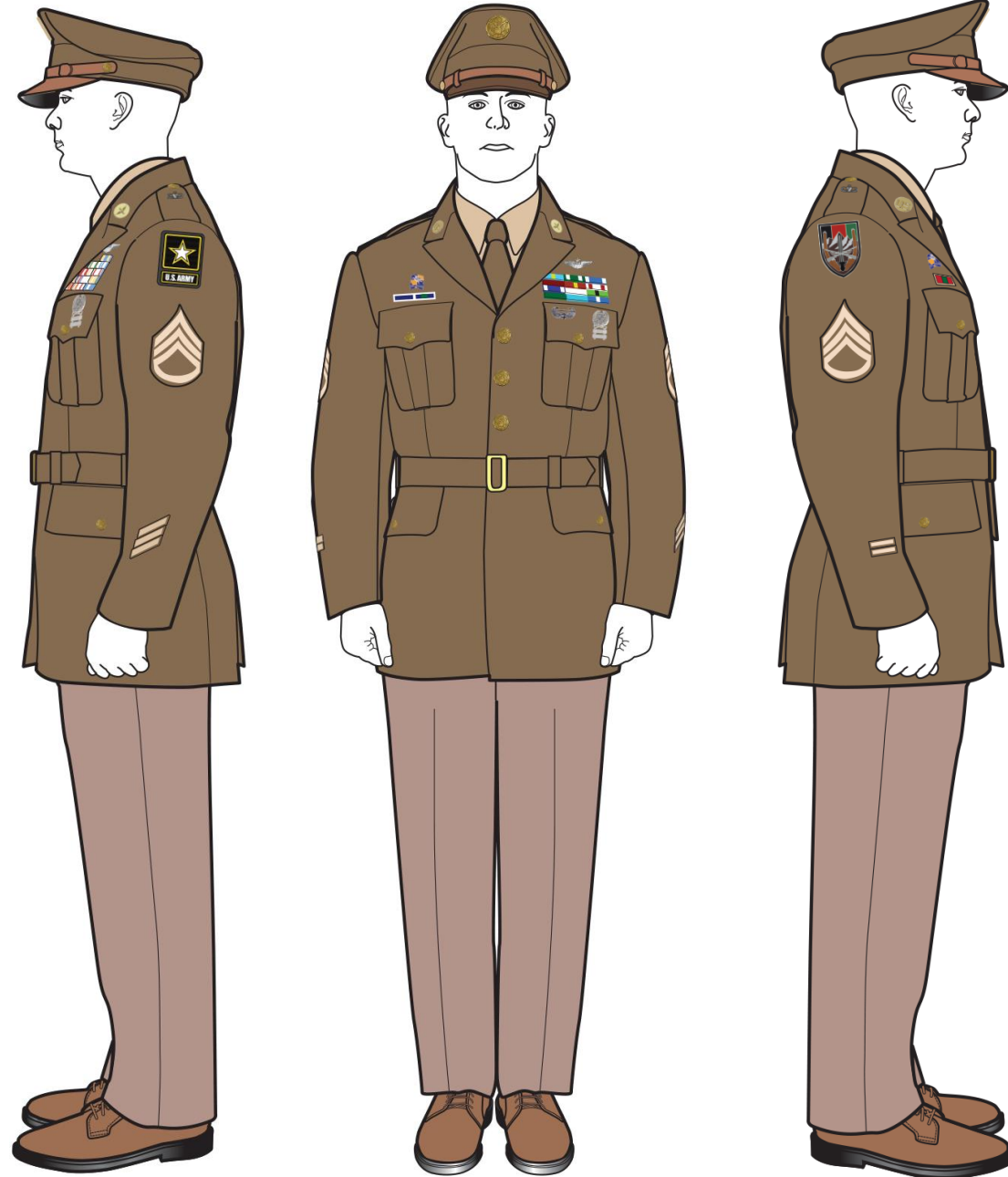


*When a tab is worn, the tab is placed 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam and the SSI is placed 1/4 inch below the tab. AGSU Enlisted Male Fit Guidelines

Coat – AGSU Male Fit:

- The coat should fit easily over the chest and shoulders.
- The shoulders should not be falling more than 1/2" past the natural shoulder point (1" total) or 3/8" narrower than the shoulder point at each side (3/4" total).
- The coat collar should fit close around the neck without gapping or overlapping, with the shirt collar showing at least 1/4 to 1/2 inch above the coat collar at the center back of the coat.
- The sleeves should fall 1 inch below the bottom of the wrist bone, covering the shirt sleeve.
- The bottom edge of the coat extends 1 inch below the crotch, falling approximately to the tip of the thumb when standing at the position of attention or not more than 1/2" below the thumb.
- Coat front and back should be smooth and even at the bottom edges, with no protruding or spreading
- Tip of the waist belt should line up with the button of the chest pocket (center of the pocket's bellows) when cinched at the waist.
- Waistline should not have more ease than 1 1/2", when belted: front of the coat should be smooth in along the lower pocket flaps.
- Flaps should not be breaking or gapping and should be smooth around the Center Back Vent of the coat.
- There can be a slight ease along the waist of the coat in the area other than pocket flaps and CB vent.



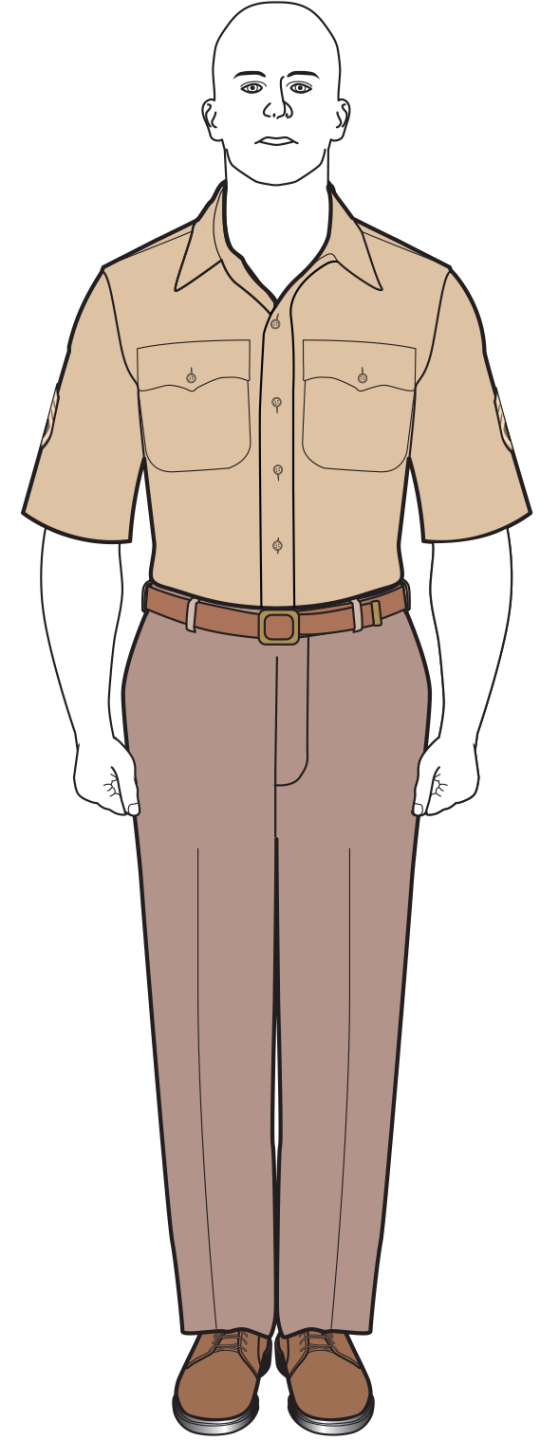
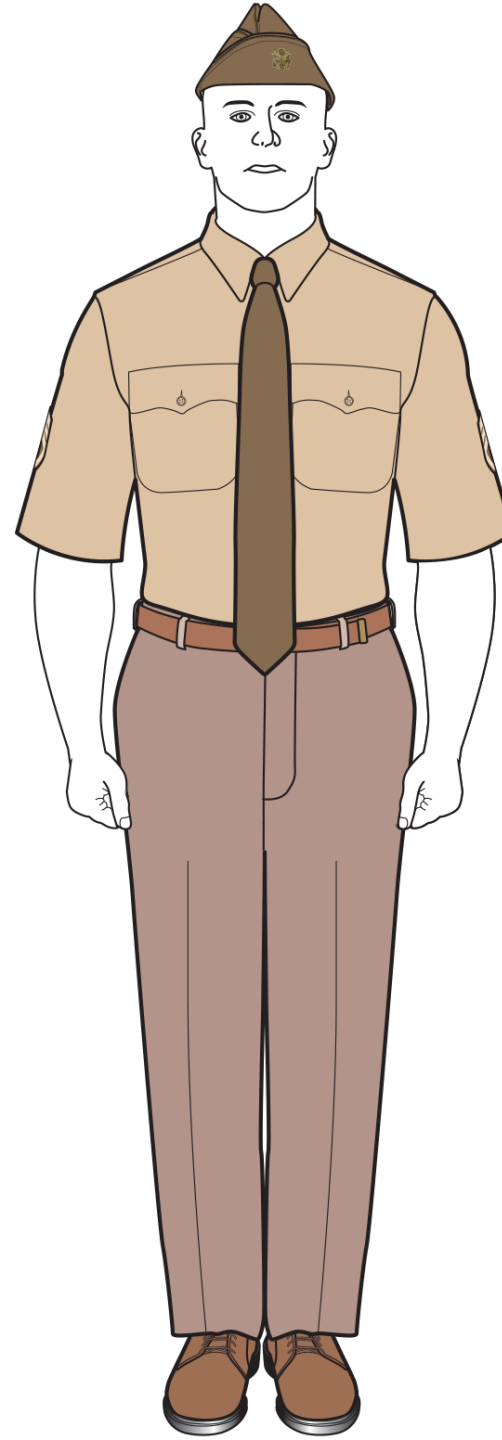
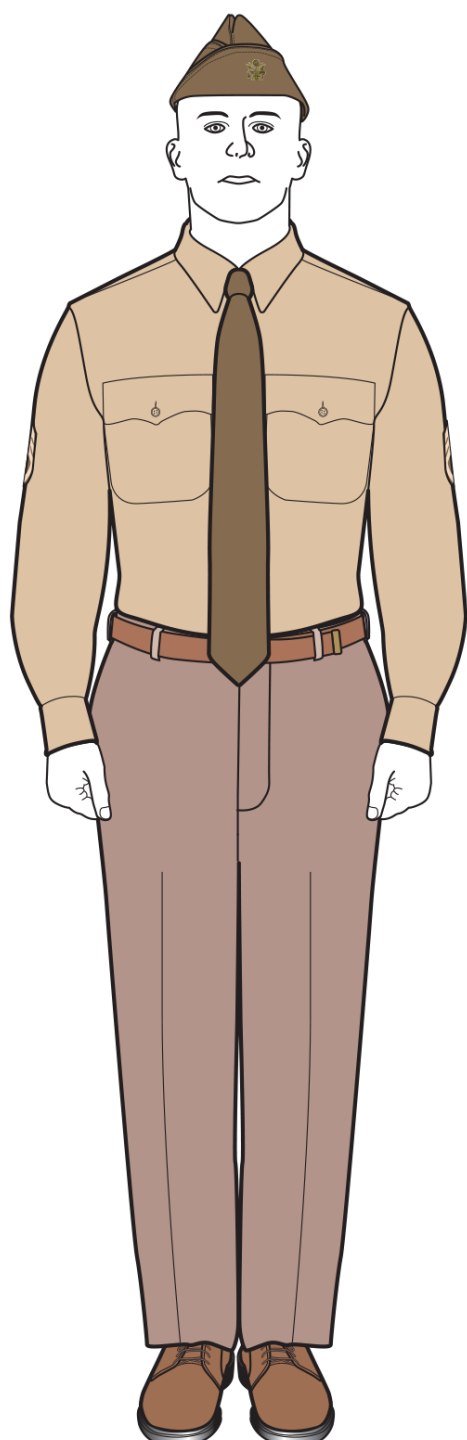

Trousers – AGSU Male Fit:

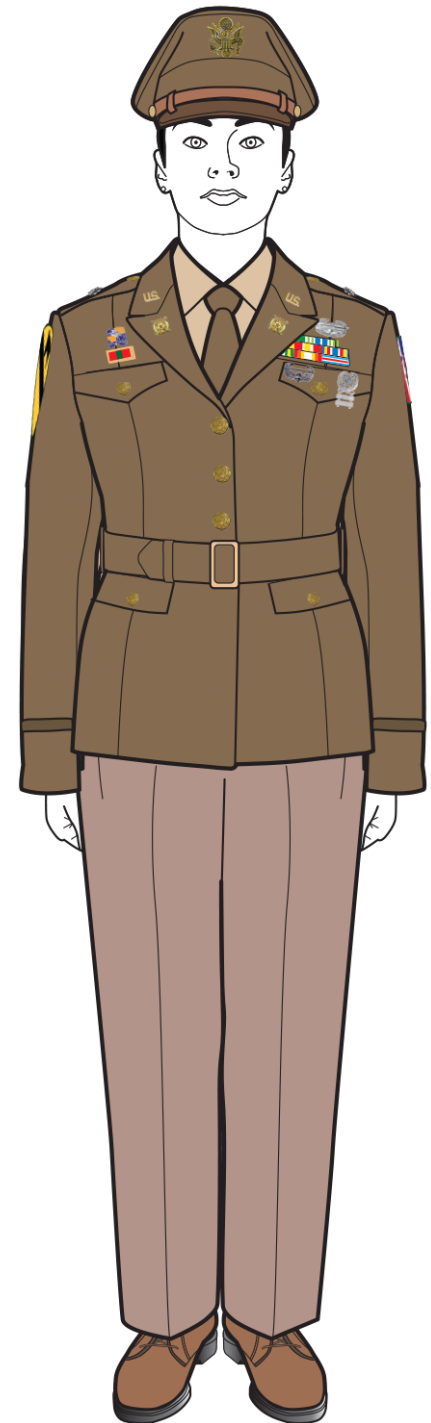
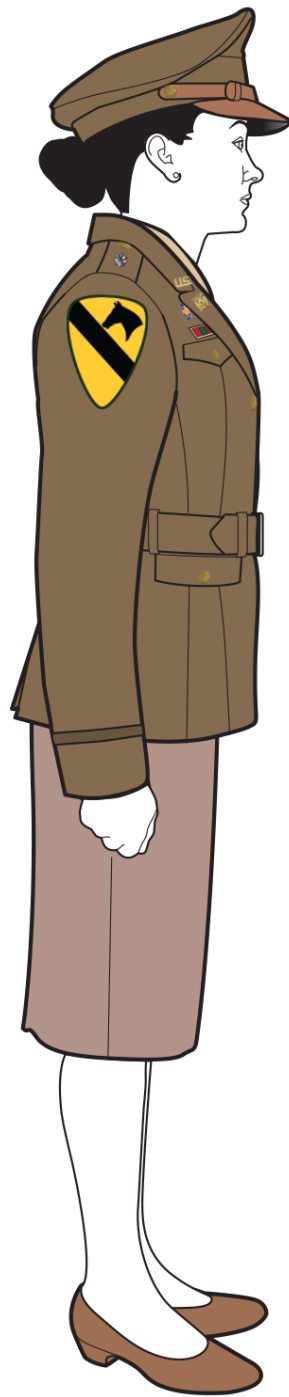
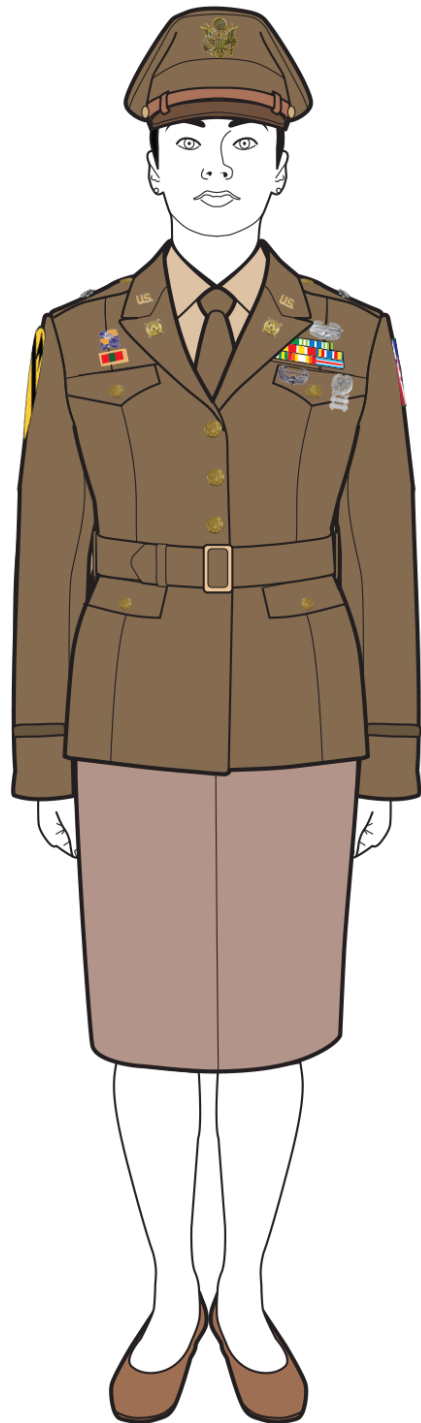
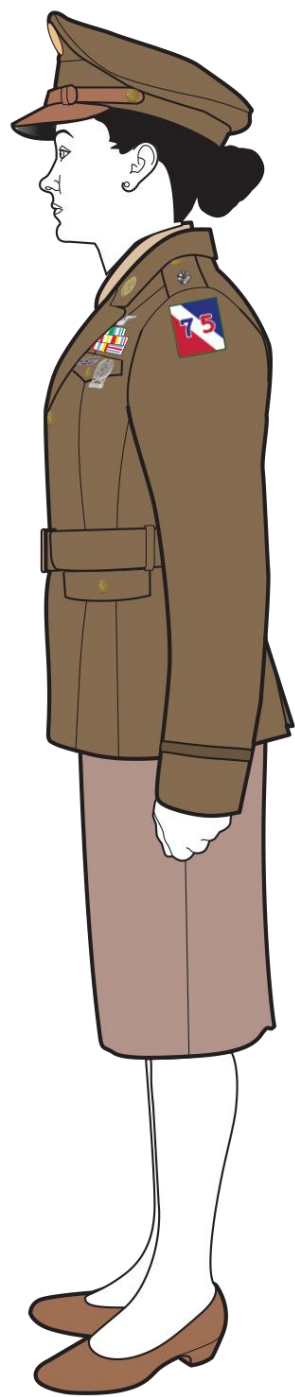
- b. General description. The low-waisted, AGSU trousers are straight-legged without cuffs, with side and hip pockets. The left hip pocket has a buttonhole tab and button
- The back hem of the trousers should fall approximately midway between the top of the heel and the top of the standard shoe in the back.
- The bottom of the front crease of the trousers should reach the top of the instep.
- The trousers may have a slight break in the front.
- The trousers should be full enough around the hips to prevent the side pockets from spreading.
- The seat must be an easy fit with no wrinkles below the back waist.
- Waist should have 1/2 inch of ease.
- The waistband bottom should fit within 1/2 inch of the top of the hipbone.



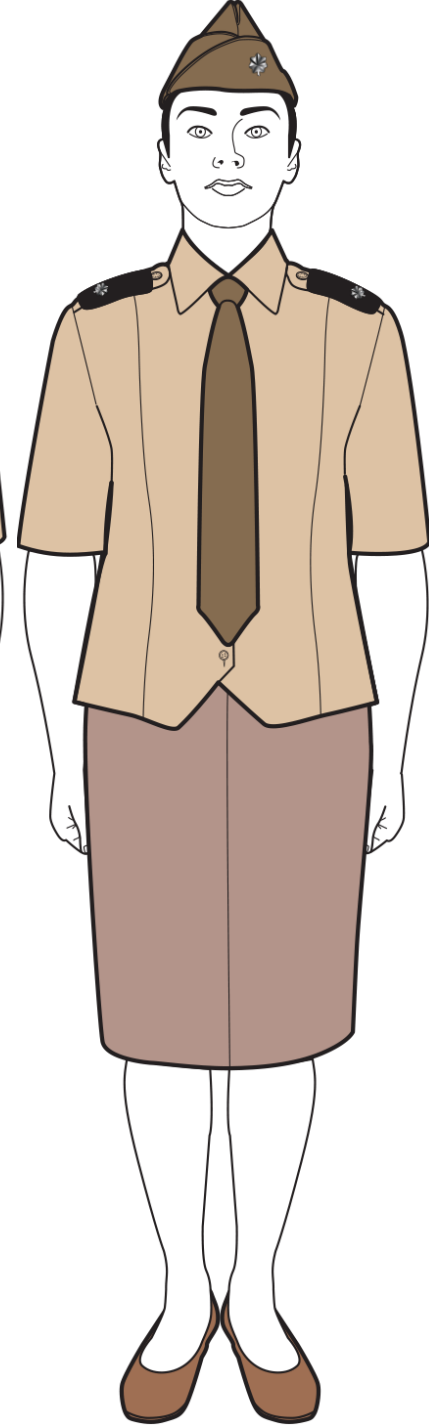
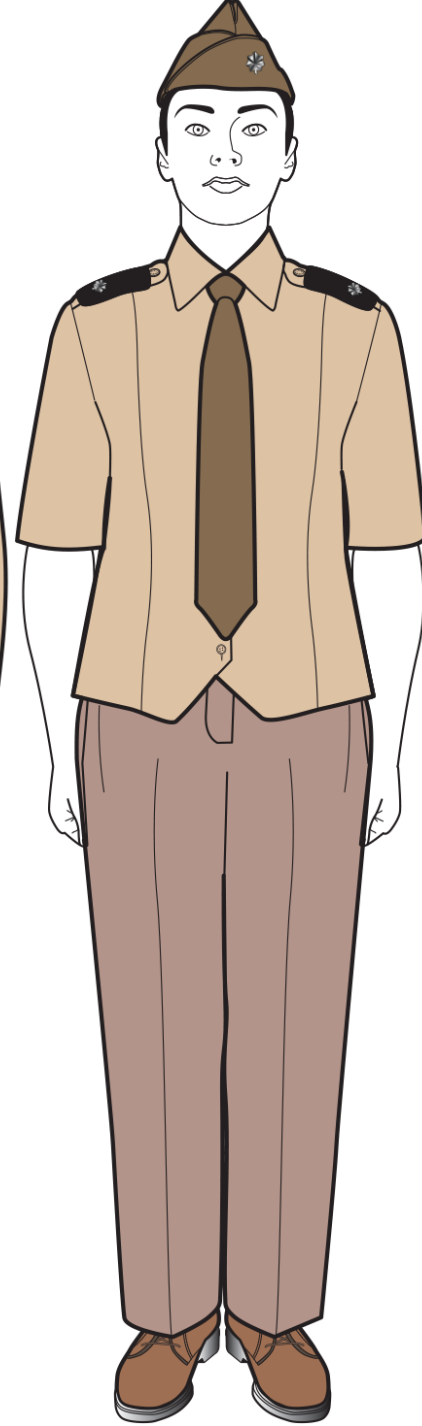
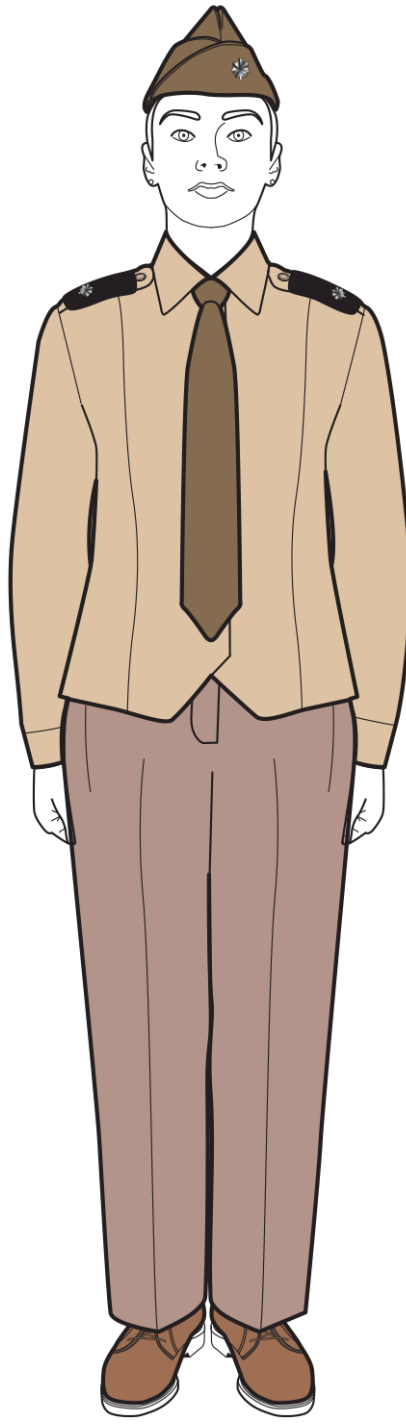
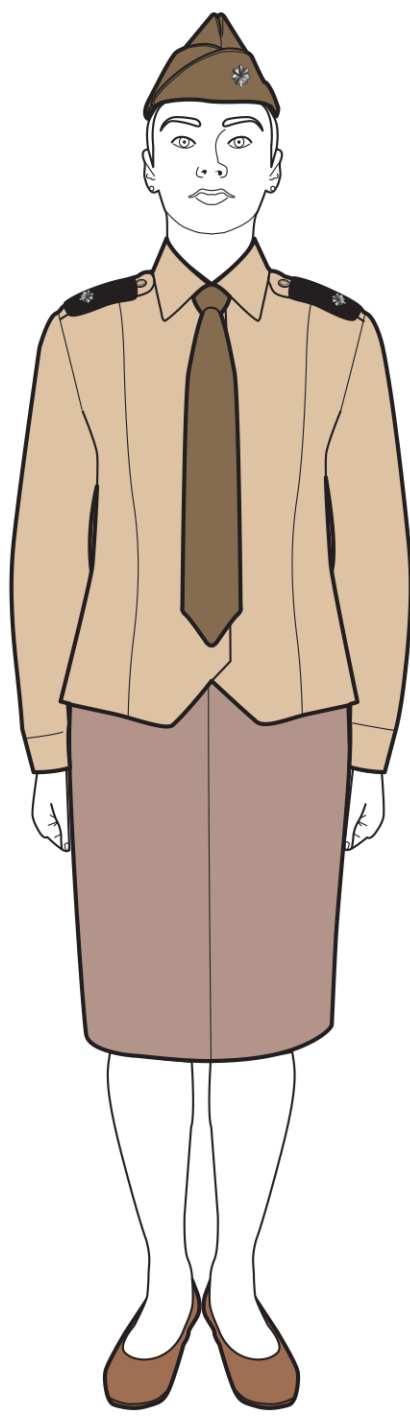
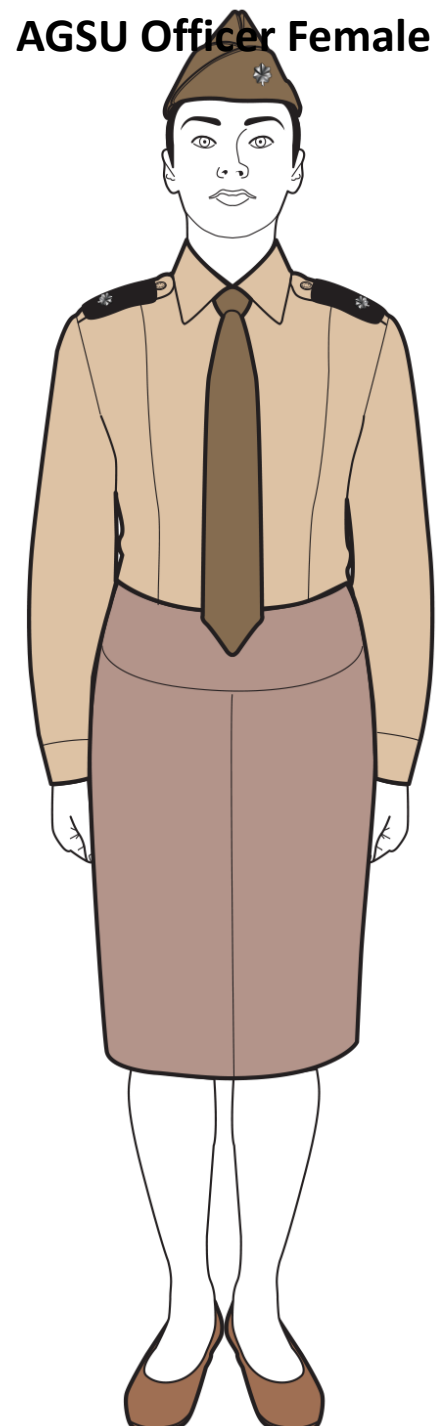

Left Sleeve	Right Sleeve
Unit Patch: Centered on sleeve cap 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam*	Combat Patch: Centered on sleeve cap 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam*
Enlisted Rank Patch: Centered on sleeve and evenly spaced between top shoulder and elbow	Enlisted Rank Patch: Centered on sleeve and evenly spaced between top shoulder and elbow
Service Stripes: Centered on the sleeve with lowest point of angle stripe 4 inches above the finished hem	Overseas Bars: Centered on the sleeve with bottom edge of the bars 4 inches above the finished hem
